

Topic – How does your garden grow?

This term pupils will learn about the lifecycle of a sunflower. They will plant their own sunflower seeds and watch them grow across the term. They will learn about what plants need to grow and take turns watering the plants throughout the week to help their plants to grow. Pupils will also learn about the different parts of a plant.



Maths – Measuring

In maths Otters will be learning about measuring and comparing lengths/weights. They will be completing practical activities to measure lengths in non-standard and standard units, comparing which objects are longer/shorter. After understanding the concepts of comparing lengths they will move on to comparing weights using the vocabulary heavier and lighter.

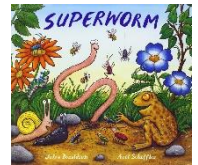
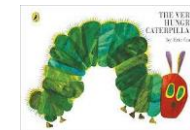
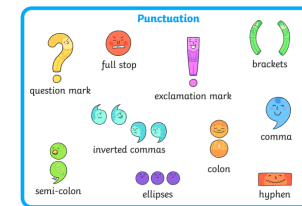


Summer term Otter class group overview



English – sensory stories / grammar and punctuation

The English focus this term is on sensory stories and punctuation. Pupils working on sensory stories will be encouraged to read along with key words in the stories and interact with the books. Some of these books will include: super worm, the very hungry caterpillar and the very busy spider. Pupils working on punctuation will learn when to put a full stop, exclamation mark or question mark at the end of a sentence. They will also be introduced to speech marks and how to use these.



PSHE – healthy lifestyles

This term Otters will be learning about healthy lifestyles. They will learn about what to expect when visiting the dentist and doctors. We are fortunate to have a visit from a dentist to talk to the pupils about the importance of brushing our teeth. Pupils will take part in practical activities such as brushing their teeth and checking them in the mirror.
