Quality of Education	<ul> <li>To consolidate knowledge and implementation of ABA teaching strategies specifically frequent practice (to increase learning opportunities) and reinforcement</li> <li>To embed the use of AAC across the school to support learning, wellbeing and peer interaction</li> </ul>
